## SPARKLING WINES

### ISTRIA

Istrian sparkling wines are characterized by freshness, aromatics, and mostly traditional bottle fermentation. This is where the five types of soil common in Croatia meet – black earth, red earth, sand, clay and clay soil – and this is just one of the secrets of the worldwide success of these wines. In addition to the indigenous varieties Teran and Malvasia, Chardonnay, Pinot, Sauvignon Blanc and numerous other varieties also ripen in Istria. In recent years, exciting new sparkling wines have been created by means of imaginative coupages, which simply have to be tasted.

## ROSÉ WINES | ISTRIA

Istrian rosé wines are high-quality, Mediterranean wines that are best known for their freshness, fruitiness and elegance. They are often described as ideal summer wines, bridging the lightness of a white wine and the structure of a red wine.

## WHITE WINES | ISTRIA

### MALVASIA

Malvazija Istarska (Istrian Malvasia) is the leading white wine variety in Istria. It is characterized by a straw yellow color, moderate acidity and 11.5 – 13.5% alcohol by volume. Typical are floral-fruity aromas (acacia, apple, apricot, almond). It is versatile, from fresh to matured (barrique) and goes ideally with fish and seafood.

## WHITE WINES | ISTRIA

### CHARDONNAY

Chardonnay from Istria is usually a fresh, structured white wine that reflects the Mediterranean climate through fruity notes of apricot and stone fruit. It is often characterized by a fine herbal note and elegant minerality. In addition to young stainless steel tank variants, there are complex versions matured in wood.

### SAUVIGNON BLANC

Sauvignon Blanc from Istria is typically a fresh and aromatic white wine with vibrant acidity and a distinct Mediterranean character. It is known for notes of citrus fruits, gooseberry and exotic fruits, complemented by delicate herbal and grassy nuances. The combination of mineral freshness and expressive aromatics makes it an elegant and versatile companion to a wide variety of dishes.

## ORANGE WINES | ISTRIA

Istrian Orange Wines are high-quality, mash-fermented white wines, which develop a deep yellow to amber colour, complex aromas and a robust structure due to long contact with grape skins (maceration time).

## WHITE WINES | SLOVENIA

Over 80% of the Slovenian white wines are known for their high quality, fresh acidity and often mineral notes, influenced by Alpine, Pannonian and Mediterranean climates. The main grape varieties are Rebula (Ribolla Gialla), Furmint (Šipon), Malvazija and Sauvignon Blanc.

### TERAN

Istrian Teran (Croatian: Teran, Slovenian: Refošk) is one of the oldest and most important indigenous red wine varieties of Istria. It is known for its strong, acidic character and deep red color.

The Merlot from Istria combines the velvety fruit of ripe berries with a lively breeze of the sea. Thanks to the calcareous soils, it never seems heavy, but retains a noble elegance and a fine, salty minerality in the finish.

Istrian dessert wines are known for their high quality, intense aromas and the combination of Mediterranean sweetness with fresh acidity. They reflect the specific terroir of the Istrian peninsula, which is characterized by calcareous soils and a mild climate.
